Dr. Maron is the C.F. Rehnborg Professor of Medicine at Stanford University School of Medicine, where he is the Chief of the Stanford Prevention Research Center and Director of Preventive Cardiology. Dr. Maron co-chairs the Right Care Initiative Technical Expert

Expert Group. He was an undergraduate at Stanford, received his medical degree from University of Southern California, and completed his residency in internal medicine at UCLA. He completed a cardiology fellowship and a research fellowship in cardiovascular disease epidemiology and prevention at Stanford University as a Robert Wood Johnson Clinical Scholar. He was on the faculty at Vanderbilt for 20 years before returning to Stanford in 2014. His research is focused on primary and secondary prevention of coronary artery disease. He chaired the Optimal Medical Therapy Committee for the VA-funded COURAGE trial and co-chaired the NHLBI-funded ISCHEMIA trial.
